Gender Justice Australia is committed to protecting your privacy and handling personal information in a transparent, respectful, and responsible way.

1. Collection of personal information

Gender Justice Australia may collect personal information that you voluntarily provide, including:

- Name
- Email address
- Organisation and role
- Information provided through contact forms, email correspondence, event registrations, consultations, or meeting bookings

2. How personal information is collected

Personal information may be collected when you:

- Contact Gender Justice Australia via the website or email
- Register for events, briefings, or training
- Participate in consultations or engagement activities
- Subscribe to updates or communications

3. Use of personal information

Personal information is collected and used for purposes including:

- Responding to enquiries
- Delivering advocacy, research, training, or engagement activities
- Managing events, consultations, or meetings
- Communicating about policy, reform, or organisational activities

Gender Justice Australia does not sell or trade personal information.

4. Storage and security

Reasonable steps are taken to protect personal information from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, or disclosure. Information may be stored electronically using secure systems and trusted third-party service providers.

5. Third-party services

Gender Justice Australia may use third-party platforms (such as email services, registration tools, or scheduling platforms). These providers may store information outside Australia and are subject to their own privacy policies.
